



In response to the COVID-19 outbreak, and based on recommendations from our Government Agencies, Local Health Officials and the Iowa Golf Association, Sheldon Golf & CC will adopt the following procedures once the golf course is able to open for the season.

- The Pro Shop will be limited to less than 10 people at a time. The doors to the clubhouse will remain open as much as possible and door handles along with high touch areas will be sanitized on a frequent basis. While in the clubhouse and on the course please adhere to the recommendation of staying 6ft apart from one another.
- All Food and Beverage will be on a 'To Go' basis. No sit-down food service or beverages, mixed drinks are NOT permitted at this time per the Governor's mandate. All chairs will be removed from the clubhouse until further notice.
- We recommend individuals take one cart per person until further notice. Rental carts will be sanitized before and after each use to prevent the spread of germs.
- There will be no ball washers, bunker rakes, water coolers, or restrooms available on the golf course until deemed appropriate. Trash receptacles will be available outside the Pro Shop.
- Our staff will rake bunkers each day. If a ball comes to rest in a disturbed area of a bunker, the player should move their ball to an undisturbed area of the bunker without penalty.
- All flagsticks on the course will have a protective Styrofoam sleeve at the base of the cup. Once your putt hits the Styrofoam, the putt is considered holed. Please DO NOT touch or remove the flagsticks or the cup itself until further notice.
- The putting green will not have holes cut until deemed appropriate, we will have cupless targets that stick into the green to putt to.
- The club will NOT provide our air or water hoses outside the clubhouse for personal cart use until further notice. Please be prepared to address your cart needs on your own. If you need air in your tires please have Jeff or Koby help you.
- When getting gas for your carts we will either provide disposable gloves or sanitizer so everyone will be safe when touching the handle and on/off switch. With the sanitizer we ask that you spray the handle and on/off switch before and after use.
